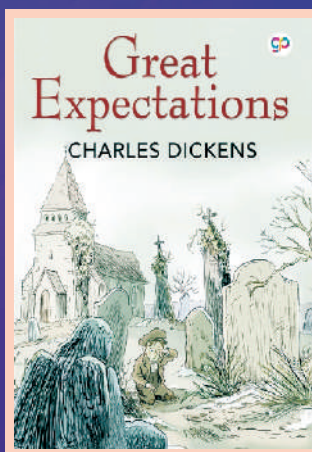


BOOK REVIEW : THE GREAT EXPECTATIONS

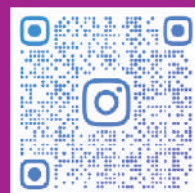
